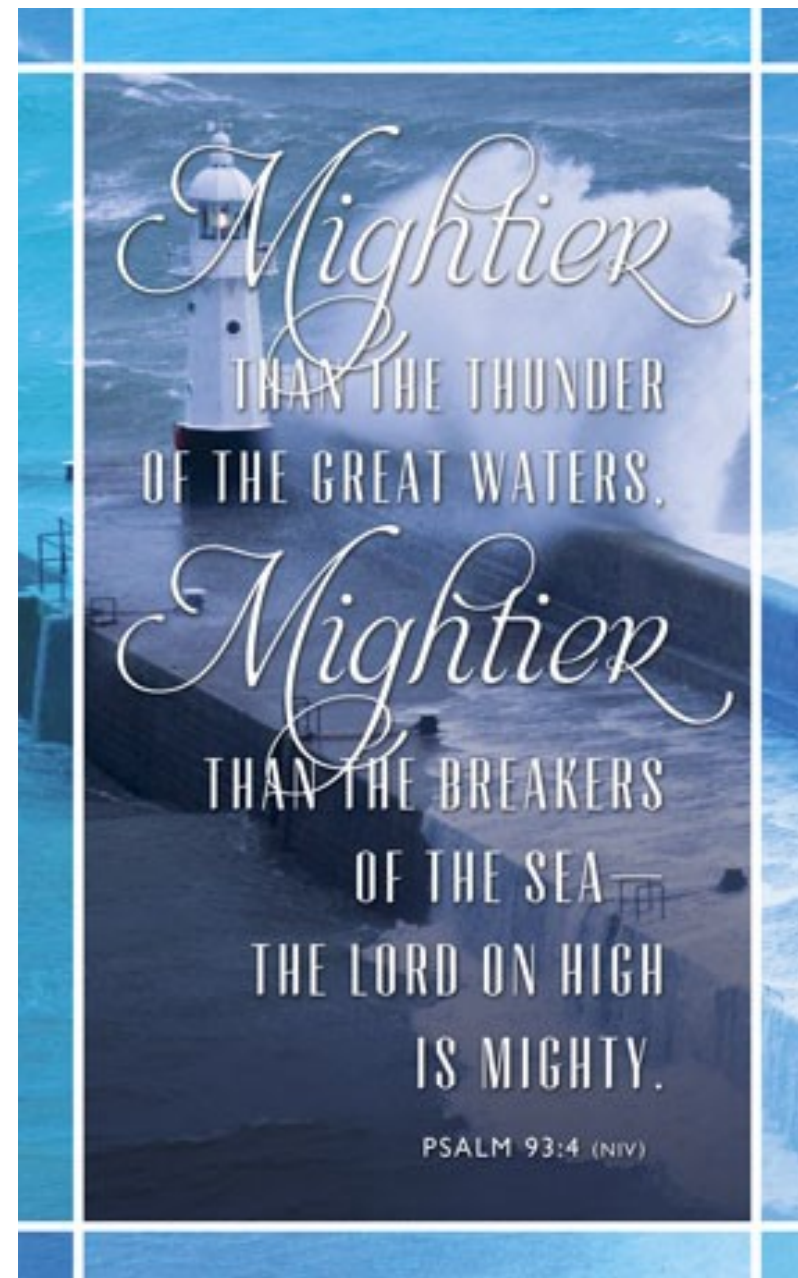

Fall Discipleship Classes begin Wednesday, August 12 and Sunday, August 16.

WEDNESDAY CLASS: 11:00 AM – NOON *Reading it Right* Facilitated by Dr. Mike Barnett. Do you approach the parables of the Bible the same way you do the miracles? 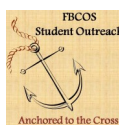
